- **Call:** HORIZON-WIDERA-2021-ERA-01-32 - Standardisation Booster for fostering exploitation of FP-funded research results and managed by the European Research Executive Agency (REA).

- Duration: April 2022 – March 2024
- Budget €2 million

- **Purpose:** Give European R&I projects the opportunity to increase their impact, gain market access and support the European green and digital agenda by using standards and contributing to standardisation

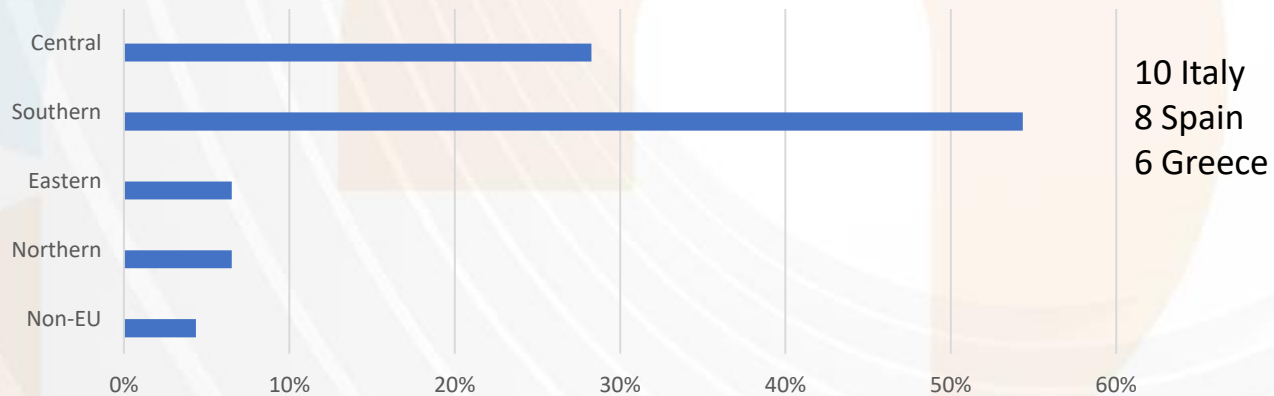

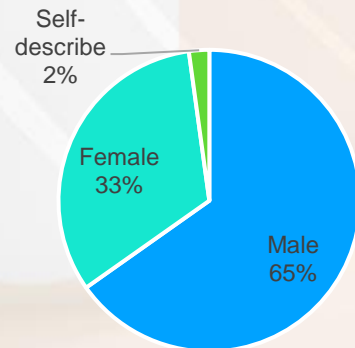

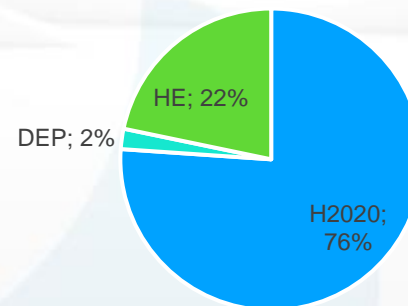
By region



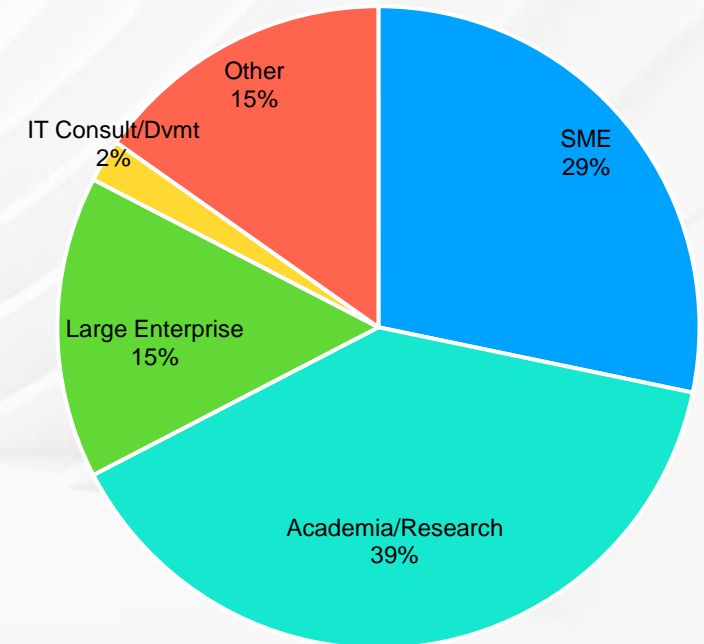

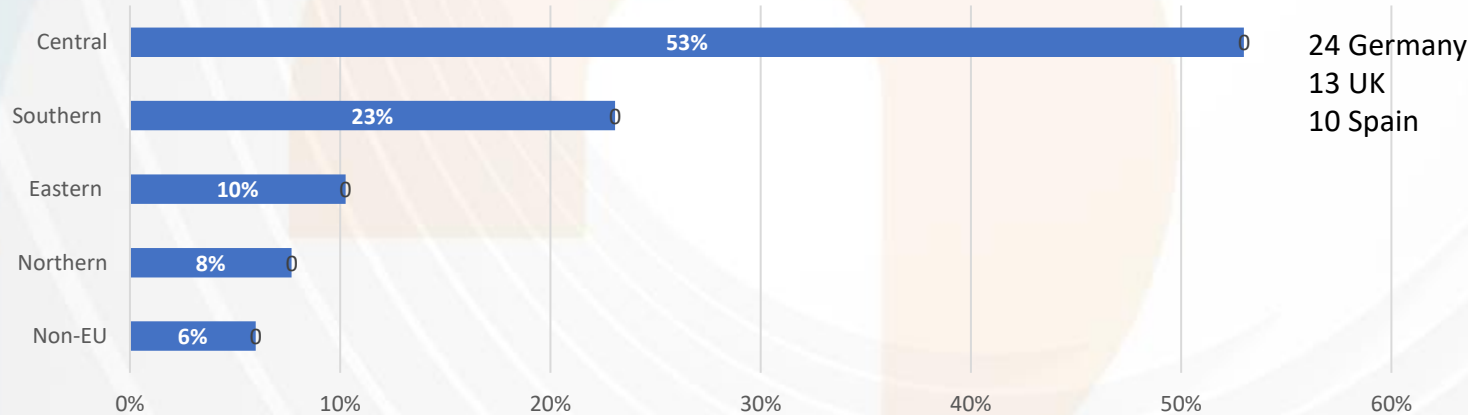

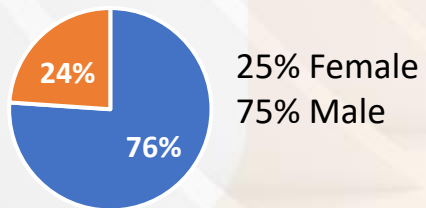
Majority of applications from southern Europe. Improved gender balance than expert applications

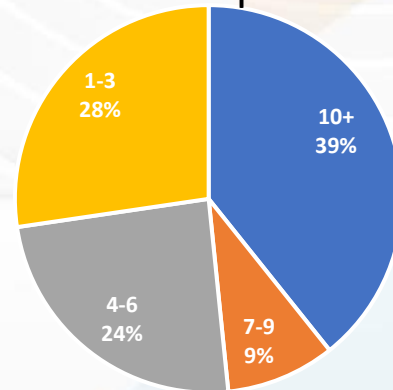

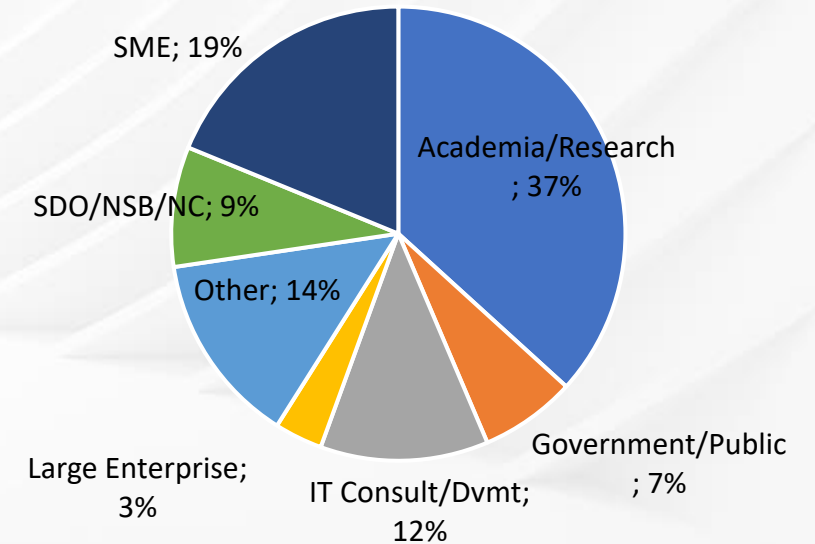

Years of experience

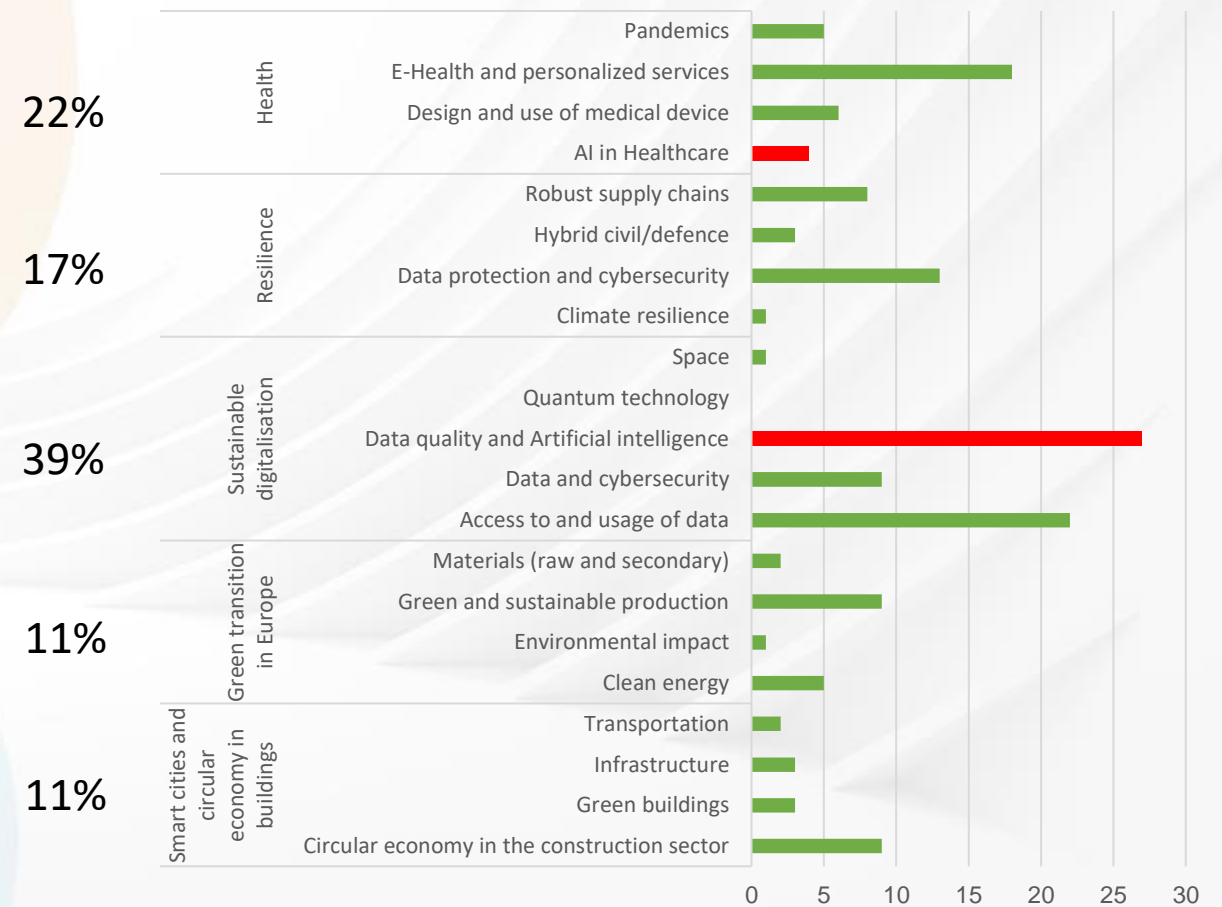
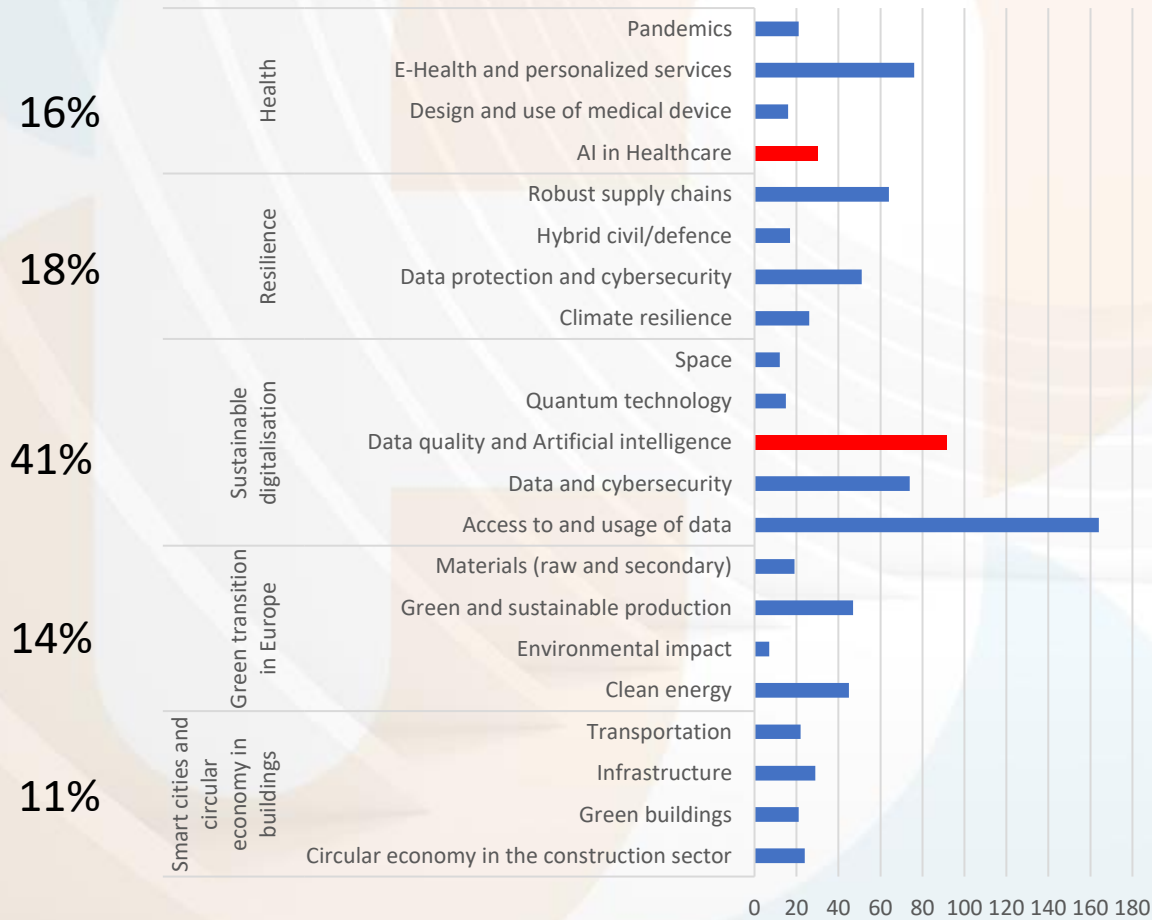


Organisation type

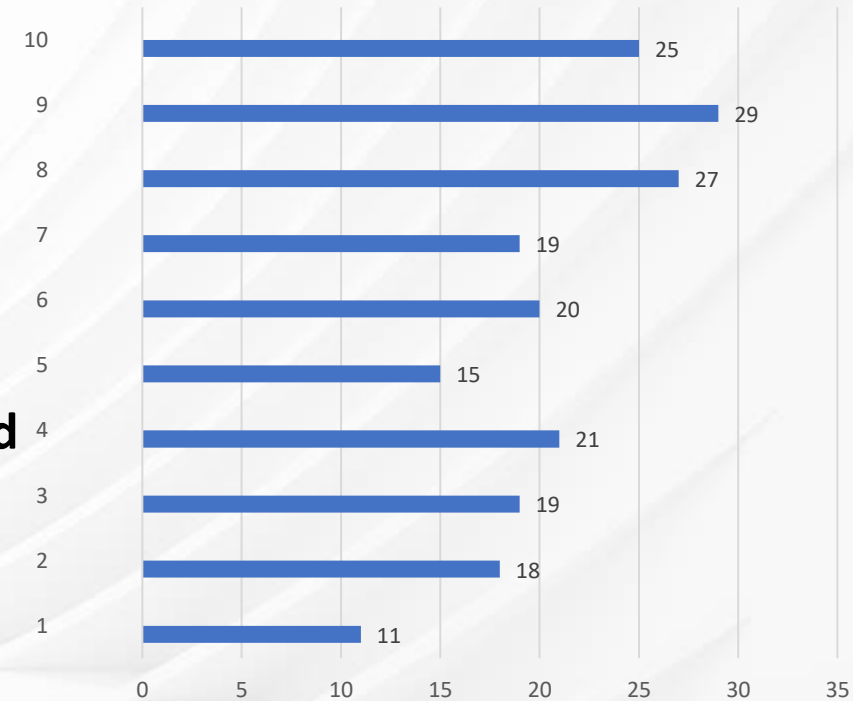
Experts vs Project applications
